75th Anniversary Concert in Cades Cove

Knoxville Symphony Orchestra**

Advance notice of weather cancellation policy

The Knoxville Symphony Orchestra is scheduled for 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 13, at the Cable Mill area in Cades Cove. Access to the event site requires a Vehicle Pass, the sale of which was concluded on June 3.

Great Smoky Mountains National Park managers have extended the opportunity to purchase vehicle passes for the 75th Anniversary outdoor concert performance by the Knoxville Symphony Orchestra on June 13 at 3 p.m. in Cades Cove. Persons interested in attending the concert will now need to purchase a pass in person between 9 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday-Friday, at the Knoxville Symphony Orchestra box office located at 100 South Gay Street, Knoxville, Tenn. The cost of the event is \$25 for vehicles with up to a 15-passenger capacity and \$50 for vehicles with a capacity greater than 15 passengers.

If you do have a pass, we recommend that you check back at this website as the concert day approaches to obtain any up-to-date information with regard to potential cancellations related to weather. A telephone hotline (865-436-1316) will also be updated with information as of June 12.

No rain date has been scheduled for this concert and the outdoor venue means that adverse weather may force a cancellation. In the event the concert must be cancelled, there will be no refunds granted to pass holders. The funds generated through pass sales will be used to pay for expenses incurred by the Knoxville Symphony Orchestra and Friends of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park.
